I. Startup Screen

II. UACP Books

- Provides searchable access to two full-text books, *Antimicrobial Chemotherapy* and *The Review of Natural Products*.

III. UACP Full Text Journals

- Provides access to 72 full-text journals (see attached list)

Advanced Search | Basic Search | Find Citation | More Fields




Browse Journals

IV. Search all Journals@Ovid

- Same as above, except no full text available (can only search abstracts and citation information)
- Covers 2,111 journals
- Useful if you want to search non-medical journals
